Professor Woodhouse has worked in the Department of Peace Studies since 1974, when he was appointed as research assistant to Professor Adam Curle. He developed the first conflict resolution teaching and research activities in the department in the mid 1980s and, in 1990, he initiated the Centre for Conflict Resolution, serving as the founding director of the Centre between 1990 and 2000. In March 1999, he was appointed to a personal chair and took the title of Professor of Conflict Resolution (Adam Curle Chair). Recent publications include Contemporary Conflict Resolution, Polity Press, (with Oliver Ramsbotham and Hugh Miall). He has published extensively on peace and conflict research and on the relationship between peacekeeping and conflict resolution.

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
