

Research conducted at the UOC seeks to tackle society's challenges and empower citizens to take an active part in the co-creation of knowledge.




We are promoting the [participatory final projects](#) programme, which lets students develop applied research in collaboration with voluntary organizations and bring their solutions to specific problems in our society.
